## ROAMer Profile: Bruce & Kathy Pike

Bruce and Kathy Pike both work full time at Walmart in Bentonville, AR. Bruce is a Senior Assistant Administrator in ISD (International Systems Development), and Kathy is an HR Clerk at Walmart Print Solutions. They both belong to Bentonville Community Church of the Nazarene.

They joined ROAM in 2014 and have been on 5 ROAM trips. Their first trip was to Pinecrest Camp near Fredericktown, MO. They have since volunteered at Camp Bond in Tishomingo, OK; Camp Arrowhead in Cleburne, TX; Salyer Lake Camp Ground in Binger, OK and their most recent work was at LifeChange Camp in Clinton, MO.

Bruce has done roofing, building, varnishing bunk beds and installing them in cabins, put tin around a wall in a Recreation building, siding, dry walled, pressure washed, hung doors and jams, plumbing, electrical, worked on sprinkler system, and other needed tasks. Kathy has painted walls, buildings, a miniature golf course; cleaned cabins, cleaned chairs, cooked, served food, laundry, washed windows, made curtains and hung the new ones, and other miscellaneous tasks.

They were able to do sightseeing on their days off (Friday, Saturday and Sunday). Mount Scott, Red Rock Canyon in Oklahoma; visit Cape Girardeau and the Mississippi River in Missouri, Sipokni – an old Wild West Town in Oklahoma, the Truman Dam Museum in Warsaw, MO and many other adventures including antique shopping.

They like the “comradery, friendships, fellowship, spiritual uplifting devotions, good food, and being able to be teased by Dan Church” (i.e. Dan asked Bruce to bring a Cherry Picker to his first trip). Bruce accuses me (Trecia Church) of bringing rain to every trip they have taken. Bruce stated, “It’s not like a full time job. It’s meaningful, and they don’t fire you if you mess up. Volunteering to help a need is rewarding.”

Comments on RV living: “It is confined, but it’s okay. Would like to have a recliner. We see pretty country. Appreciates the Camp owners, they are really nice. They are patient with our different levels of experience.”
