

ROAM Membership Commitment

A Nazarene Lay Ministry

ROAM members shall:

- 1. Be in agreement with ROAM Mission Statement and profess to be a follower of Jesus Christ.
- 2. Place work requests through the ROAM office and allow them to make the initial contact when requesting to work a project for the first time.
- 3. Carry their own insurance and release project hosts from responsibility for personal injury or damage to their property.
- 4. Refrain from drinking any alcoholic beverages, smoking, use of tobacco, and conduct themselves in a respectable manner, using no undesirable language while on a project.
- 5. Not solicit funds for any reason, personal or otherwise.
- 6. Be certain pets are allowed at project site before arriving. Keep pets on leash at all times; clean up after them.
- 7. Not attempt jobs that they feel are beyond their ability.
- 8. Make no unauthorized purchases.
- 9. Understand that a work project will typically start the first Monday of the month, with ROAM members arriving on the Friday or Saturday before, unless the project host approves an alternate schedule for individual ROAMers.
- 10. Abide by the recommended length of stay, which is a three-week work project, unless the host approves a different length of time ahead of the ROAMers' arrival.
- 11. Recommended hours are:
 - a. For ROAMers traveling alone, plan to work 6 hours per day, 4 days per week, unless the work tasks do not require that number of hours.
 - b. For ROAMers that travel with a spouse or other ROAM member in their RV, one member should plan to work 6 hours per day, 4 days per week and the additional ROAM member should plan to work 3 hours per day, 4 days a week unless the host has specifically approved another number of hours.
 - ROAMers can work additional hours/days if they feel they are able and there is work to be done, but it is not required.
- 12. Work within the established schedule approved by the host except for personal emergencies or other circumstances.
- 13. Adjust work shifts to accommodate host. Understand that they are to do the jobs as the host desires them to be done.
- 14. Work with the Team Leader to determine how best the project work should be done. If there is no team leader, the ROAM member will communicate directly with the project host for instructions about the tasks.
- 15. Consider carrying the ROAM Emergency Information slip on their person at all times.
