Cornerstone Church - Lake Jackson, TX

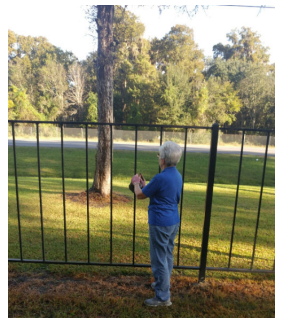
