Dear Pastor or Project Host:

Thank you for considering how ROAM might help your organization. This packet of information for requesting ROAM volunteers should answer most of your questions and provides an Application for Assistance form for you to complete and send to the ROAM office in the self-addressed envelope.

ROAM provides workers as they are available on a monthly basis. Our workday is typically 6 hours per day for ROAMers traveling alone and 3 hours per day for additional ROAM members in an RV, usually 4 days a week (Mon thru Thurs). The work month is 3 weeks (generally the first three weeks of the month), unless you feel you would like to approve someone's work request for different days/weeks/hours. ROAM workers provide labor only and pay their own travel expenses, although the host provides the RV space for free.

We ask each host to complete an Application for Assistance that provides enough information to advertise the project to our members in sufficient detail for them to decide if they would want to volunteer. Please complete all requested information. (Do not sign or return the Commitment form. It is for your information only.)

In addition to the information on the application form, we ask that you provide directions to RV sites and worksites. Your volunteers may never have been to your area so we ask for as much detail as you can provide. Refer to the nearest large city, a main road junction or highway exit number as the start point. Then describe in detail the description of turns, etc., (Example: Turn right at McDonalds) and detailed instructions to the RV sites.

All project expenses are the responsibility of the host. As the host, you must provide free hook-ups for the RVs in return for labor. The minimum requirements are:

RV Sites

1. 50 AMP electricity preferred (30 amp minimum)
2. Fresh water hook-up
3. Permanent Sewer dump at the site (4" pipe), (If no sewer, you may provide a Honey Wagon, Macerator Pump or PVC Pipe)
4. Road access for RV's
5. RV sites large enough to accommodate large rigs (30-40') and possibly longer if they ROAMer has a 5th wheel unit.

Other Facilities

1. Phone access available for 24 hour emergency use
2. Computer port or wireless
3. A room for devotions if there will be more than ROAM couple at a time at your project.
